Elevated Holiday Entertaining

Balsamic-Roasted Grape and Burrata Crostini

Prep time: 15 minutes
Cook time: 30 minutes
Servings: 8

- 3 cups red or black Grapes from California
- 1/4 cup white or traditional balsamic vinegar
- 2 tablespoons extra-virgin olive oil
- 1/4 teaspoon sea salt
- 8 ounces burrata cheese
- 3 tablespoons roasted, salted pistachio kernels, coarsely chopped
- fresh basil, snipped
- 24 soft or toasted baguette slices

Preheat oven to 425 F and line baking sheet with large piece of foil; fold in sides slightly to form rim.

Place grapes on foil and top with vinegar, olive oil and sea salt. Stir lightly to coat grapes. Roast 30 minutes, stirring every 10 minutes. Let cool slightly.

Place cheese in decorative shallow bowl and top with grapes. Sprinkle with pistachios and basil. Serve with baguette slices.

Lemony Grapes and Greens Salad

Prep time: 25 minutes Servings: 6

Lemon Vinaigrette:

- 1/4 cup extra-virgin olive oil
- 3 tablespoons lemon juice
- 1 tablespoon honey
- 2 teaspoons spicy brown or stone-ground mustard
- 1 garlic clove, minced
- 1/8 teaspoon sea salt
- 1/8 teaspoon pepper

Salad:

- 10 cups mixed torn greens (endive, watercress, frisee or butter lettuce)

- 1 1/2 cups halved Grapes from California
- 1/2 cup sliced red onion
- 1 large firm but ripe avocado, peeled, pitted and diced
- 1/3 cup roasted, salted pistachio kernels

To make lemon vinaigrette: In small bowl, whisk olive oil, lemon juice, honey, mustard, garlic, salt and pepper.

To make salad: In large bowl, mix greens, grapes and onion. Drizzle with dressing and toss well to coat. Add avocado and toss lightly. Sprinkle with pistachios.

Grape Basil Martini

Servings: 1

- 3 basil leaves, torn, plus 1 full leaf for garnish
- 5 green Grapes from California, halved, plus 2 whole grapes for garnish
- 2 ounces gin
- 1/4 ounce sweet muscat wine
- 1 ounce lemon juice
- 1 ounce simple syrup
- ice

In cocktail shaker, muddle basil and grapes with gin. Add sweet wine, lemon juice and simple syrup; shake gently.

Strain into rocks glass filled with ice. Garnish with basil leaf and float two grapes on top.

HOLIDAYS 2024: ARE SHOPPERS AND RETAILERS IN SYNC?

The holiday season is a time most retailers, and people who love celebrating and gift-giving, look forward to above all. While making predictions may seem risky, a number of indicators point to a jolly holiday season for shoppers and retailers alike this year. To get our finger on the pulse of 2024 shoppers, Coveo conducted an annual holiday shopping outlook report, "Gift or Grinch? Unwrapping This Season's Shopper Spending Plans," based on a survey of 4,000 consumers in the U.S. and U.K., in partnership with Arlington Research. Going a step further, we compared those shoppers' views with retailer perceptions from last year's holiday report surveying retail executives from 92 U.S.-based retailers, most with revenues above \$250M.

The upshot? Many approaches top retailers are pursuing to improve retail sales - optimizing Black Friday/Cyber Week events, using AI to offer shoppers personalized recommendations and maximizing promotions to improve shopper loyalty - also create what shoppers want: opportunities to find the perfect gifts for everyone on their list while scoring great deals.

2024 consumer shopping outlook

Over three-fourths of surveyed shoppers (76%) say they plan to maintain or increase gift purchases this year, which retailers will be happy to hear. In fact, 59% of shoppers say they plan to cut down on everyday purchases to prioritize their gifting budgets.

While the 2023 retailer survey found that most retailers (84%) feel consumers can get deals anytime, the majority of retailers (58%) believe holiday events remain a powerful source of revenue, with 76% of the above-average retail performers supporting this idea. Retailers say they approach the shopping peak as a coordinated effort to create brand excitement, and shoppers agree.

In the Coveo 2024 Holiday Shopping Report, 68% of U.S. shoppers said they plan to shop at one or more stores on Black Friday or Cyber Monday, with big box/department stores being the top

holiday shopping category. Electronic stores (37%) and fashion/apparel (36%) were the top two shopping choices for Black Friday or Cyber Monday.

Generative AI and the online shopping experience

There's no question AI has changed - and will continue changing - how we shop. For retailers, that means learning how technology can create a positive user experience that also drives sales and builds brand loyalty. For consumers, this means making the search for the perfect gift seamless: a quicker, more personalized, more convenient and satisfying way to shop.

The Coveo 2024 Holiday Shopping Report found digital shopping continuing its upward trend, with 80% of shoppers finding special offers purely through digital channels (email, social media, online search and online marketplaces). Shoppers appreciate shopping assistance, with 61% of consumers saying that pre-set search categories like "gifts for dad" or "gifts under \$50" are helpful. Nearly one in three shoppers (31%) also say having generative AI provide specific holiday gifting recommendations would be useful - rising to nearly half (44%) for millennials.

When it comes to online shopping, shoppers are only a browser window away from a better experience. Shoppers expect personalized and relevant experiences, similar to what they would get from a knowledgeable store associate. Only AI can effectively help companies successfully deliver individualized, trusted and connected experiences at a scale that meets and exceeds people's expectations. And if you add GenAI to the mix, you can not only provide shoppers with answers, but you can provide them with a deeper level of advice - such as which lotion is best for your particular skin type or problem area.

Offers and promotions tailor-made for success

The Coveo 2024 Holiday Shopping Report also found an impressive 90% of shoppers are open to adding items to their existing orders during the holidays, presenting a golden opportunity for




retailers to boost sales. Offers like free shipping, relevant special promotions and personalized recommendations also delight shoppers by helping them find the perfect gift while maximizing value.

When this year's survey asked consumers what would compel them to add to an existing order when shopping online, "Meeting the minimum spend to get free shipping" was the top answer (62%). The second highest response was, "Relevant special offers popping up" (48%), followed by "Recommendations for family members" and "Recommendations for other items" (both 26%).

Top-performing retailers from the 2023 study recognized this growing interest in receiving relevant personalized offers. Clearly on track with what today's shoppers expect, 90% of retail executive respondents said the ability to provide personalized offers was moving from "nice-to-have" to "must-have."

The surveys of both retailers and consumers make it clear that "one-size-fits-all" thinking no longer motivates sales. In today's digital, AI-powered shopping landscape, it's crucial to offer increasingly personalized offers and deals both to please consumers and to stay competitive. Business success during the busy holiday season means creating deliberate, hyper-personalized, focused strategies that reach and delight each consumer, wherever they are on their shopping journey.

BEYOND THE CELLAR: A CELEBRATION OF EXCEPTIONAL WINES AND CULINARY BRILLIANCE

For wine lovers, Beyond the Cellar at The Lodge at Torrey Pines was an absolute delight. Held in the stunning coastal setting of La Jolla, this event brought together an impressive lineup of wineries alongside gourmet culinary offerings for an unforgettable evening. With world-class wines and dishes crafted by Executive Chef Kelli Crosson's team, the experience was both indulgent and inspiring.

The evening showcased iconic wineries, mostly hailing from Napa Valley and Sonoma County, with Daou Family Estates' Patrimony standing out as the sole representative from Paso Robles. Having attended countless tastings over the years, I can confidently say this was among the finest—every detail meticulously curated to wow guests.

Darioush: National Sales Director Roman Palumbo brought his enthusiasm and charm, making each pour feel like a special moment. The 2021 Mount Veeder Cabernet Sauvignon was bold and structured, with layers of blackberry and subtle oak spice. The 2021 Shiraz from Napa Valley delivered rich, spicy depth with notes of black pepper and ripe plum. The 2023 Viognier, with its lively notes of stone fruit and citrus, added a refreshing balance to the evening's red-heavy lineup.

Patrimony Estate:

Eryn Schnitzer, Southern California Business Development Manager, showcased Patrimony's excellence through vertical tastings. Patrimony, the Daou brothers' exclusive brand and legacy, represents the pinnacle of their winemaking journey. Daniel Daou, master director of winemaking, ensures every bottle reflects the unique terroir of DAOU Mountain in Paso Robles. The 2020 and 2021 Caves des Lions blends of Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc were layered and complex, with hints of dark cherry, cedar, and violets.

The 100% Cabernet Sauvignons from the same years exhibited incredible depth, velvety tannins, and a long, luxurious finish. Crafted entirely from

free-run juice, these wines capture the essence of their Adelaida District estates limestone-rich soils and meticulous winemaking.

Chappellet:

President David Francke and his wife Tammy offered an exceptional lineup that demonstrated the winery's storied legacy in Napa Valley. The 2023 Signature Chenin Blanc was a delightful surprise, offering floral aromas and a clean, mineral-driven palate. The 2021 Pritchard Hill Cabernet Sauvignon—Chappellet's crown jewel—expressed bold tannins, deep fruit, and impeccable balance, standing out among the evening's offerings.

Far Niente and Nickel & Nickel: Bruce Mooers, President of Sales, brought a tasting experience that paired beautifully with the nearby carving station. The 2023 Far Niente Napa Valley Chardonnay was crisp and vibrant, while the 2022 Nickel & Nickel De Carle Rutherford Cabernet Sauvignon and 2022 Nickel & Nickel Fog Break Atlas Peak Cabernet Sauvignon highlighted the diversity of Napa's subregions. The De Carle was elegant, with red currant and fine tannins, while the Fog Break impressed with its intense dark fruit and savory earthiness. The 2018 Far Niente Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon rounded out the tasting, offering bold, balanced flavors that complemented the prime rib perfectly.

Ramey Wine Cellars:

Founder David Ramey and his wife Carla poured an impressive selection, emphasizing their focus on terroir-driven wines. The 2021 Woolsey Road Russian River Valley Chardonnay was elegant and layered, with notes of apple, pear, and a hint of hazelnut. The 2017 Rogers Creek Shiraz delivered smoky complexity, showcasing Ramey's mastery of Sonoma and Napa terroirs. The 2014 Annum Cabernet Sauvignon stood out for its balance, with black cherry, cedar, and a long, velvety finish.

ZD Wines: Teresa D'Aurizio, VP of Marketing and Sales, pulled out all the stops, highlighting ZD's extraordinary Abacus Cabernet Sauvignon. This

Other offerings, like the 2022 Carneros Reserve Chardonnay and 2013 Reserve Cabernet, further showcased ZD's versatility and commitment to crafting exceptional wines.

Staglin Family Vineyards:

Winemaker Matt Peterson poured a trio of outstanding wines. The 2023 Salus Chardonnay was fresh and lively, with notes of tropical fruit and a creamy texture. The 2021 Salus Cabernet Sauvignon delivered structured tannins with ripe plum and black currant, while the 2018 Staglin Cabernet Sauvignon was opulent, with layers of dark fruit, cocoa, and a velvety finish with eucalyptus and mint undertones. Each wine reflected Staglin's focus on sustainability and quality.

Hundred Acre:

Dana Madison, Western Regional Sales Manager, presented a selection that captivated the palate. The 2021 Fortunate Son: The Dreamer Cabernet Sauvignon was rich and velvety, while the 2024 Summer Dreams Pinot Noir was vibrant and perfectly balanced.

500 STRONG: DOVE DASH MARKS 50 YEARS OF HOPE AND HEALING FOR BRAIN INJURY SURVIVORS

The 24th Annual Dove Dash was a day to remember, with the sun shining brightly over Dove Canyon as more than 500 participants gathered to celebrate an inspiring milestone: 50 years of service from the High Hopes Head Injury Program. The event brought together community members, families, and friends, all eager to support the life-changing rehabilitation services that High Hopes provides for individuals with traumatic brain injuries. It was a day full of energy, camaraderie, and a deep sense of purpose.

The morning began with an energetic warm-up session, setting the tone for what was to come. The Rancho Santa Margarita Christian School students, Everly Guerra (9), Katrina Pishney (12), and Brooklyn Lysek (9), accompanied by Mary Desmond, gave a beautiful performance of the National Anthem, prompting cheers and applause from the crowd. Following this patriotic tribute, 40 doves were released into the sky, a poignant symbol of hope and resilience, marking the start of the event.

The races kicked off with a horn blast, sending runners and walkers alike off on their scenic courses through Dove Canyon. The 5k and Family 1k events saw participants of all ages giving it their all, from experienced runners to those enjoying their first-ever community run. His lively commentary and warmth kept spirits high, ensuring everyone felt like a winner. 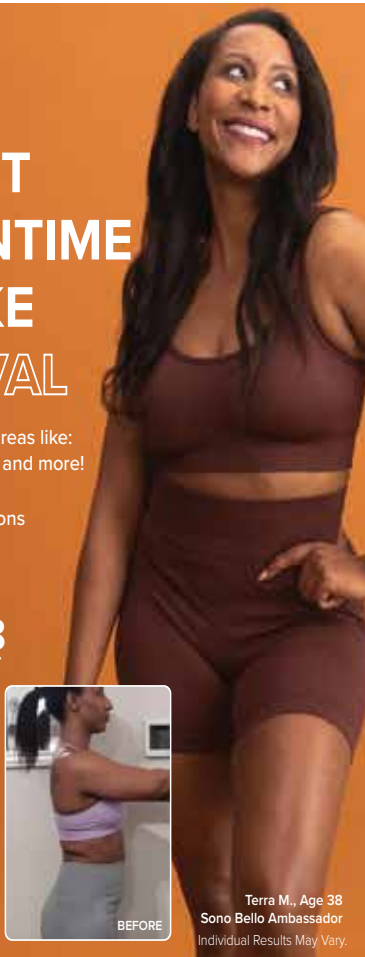
